

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE "UNTIL THE DAY DAWN CEMETERY"

The Town of Angelica does hereby adopt and enact the following Rules and Regulations as set forth herein.

1. All gravesite owners and contractors shall be subject to all **Rules and Regulations** of the Cemetery of the Town of Angelica, known as "**Until the Day Dawn Cemetery**" and to all rules which may hereafter be made and approved by the Town Board of the Town of Angelica.
2. Cemetery grounds are open dawn to dusk daily.
3. **All gravesites in the Cemetery are sold in accordance with the provisions of the Laws of the State of New York and are not to be used for any purpose other than as a burial place for deceased human beings. All applications for the purchase of a gravesite(s) must be made to the Town Clerk of the Town of Angelica. A Certificate of Title will be given only after completion of the application in full.**
4. The owner of any cemetery gravesite(s), shall **NOT** transfer ownership to another party without first making legal notification to the Town Clerk of the Town of Angelica either by:
 - A Certified copy of the Will showing the name(s) of the heirs, or
 - Surrender of the gravesite(s) with proof of purchase to the Town of Angelica for the purchase price paid, without interest. Payment of interest is withheld for the purpose of gravesite(s) maintenance.
 - The owner of a gravesite(s) cannot allow any interment to be made on his or her gravesite(s) for compensation.
5. **No interment shall be allowed without permission being first obtained from the Town Clerk of the Town of Angelica.** At the time of application for permission the following must be furnished: **A BURIAL-TRANSIT PERMIT** or **The CERTIFICATE OF CREMATION**. At the time of permit application, the following information must be presented to the Town Clerk of the Town of Angelica:
 - Contact person's (Informant) name, address, phone or place of contact.
 - Deceased name, sex and age.
 - Date and place of birth.
 - Requested date and time of interment.
 - If the deceased is NOT AN ADULT, the name(s) of parents or legal guardians is required.
6. **All gravesites must be paid for in full at the time of purchase.** The gravesite price includes permanent maintenance (grass mowing and trimming only).
7. Interments, monuments/markers, monument foundations are all costs borne by the family or the estate of the deceased and must be prepaid to the Town of Angelica prior to the start of work.
8. Only one monument is allowed at the head of the grave. One additional Marker will be allowed at the foot so long that it is a "grass marker" and is flush with the ground so as not to interfere with mowing.
9. All work performed in the cemetery will be performed only by employees of the Town of Angelica or authorized, insured persons under contract with the Town of Angelica. No work of any kind may be performed by any authorized and insured contractor without first securing all proper permits from the Town Clerk of the Town of Angelica and providing the Clerk with a Certificate of Insurance naming the Town of Angelica as additional insured. This work includes, but is not limited to the following:
 - Installation of concrete monument foundations.
 - Gravesite burial openings or cremation openings.

- NOTE: The use of lawn mowers, power grass trimmers, chainsaws or rototillers by anyone other than an employee of the Town of Angelica is forbidden.
10. All monuments or markers must be constructed of granite, marble or bronze.
 11. No monument will be allowed to be delivered in the cemetery until the foundation is installed and ready to receive the monument. NO "grass setting" is permitted.
 12. All living or artificial flowers and plants are to be contained in permanent urns or temporarily affixed to the monuments. No glass containers may be used either above or below the ground for flowers. The Town of Angelica reserves the right to remove (without notification) all flowers, wreaths, or other decorations as soon as they become unsightly. Funeral flowers will be removed by town employees the third day after the funeral.
 13. All living, artificial flowers, plants or perishable decorations must be removed from all graves and monuments by November 1st of each year. The Town employees will do so and discard items if living family members of the deceased do not do so by the November 1st date. New living or artificial flowers may not be placed in permanent urns or temporarily affixed to the monuments any earlier than April 1st or Easter of each year, whichever comes first.
 14. Planting of trees, shrubs, plants or flowers, not contained in permanent urns, is forbidden unless authorized by the Town Board of the Town of Angelica.
 15. No brick, stone or artificial borders around gravesite or monument foundations are permitted.
 16. Cremation remains will not be scattered in any part of the cemetery.
 17. The interment of cremated remains will be permitted only in appropriate rigid receptacles such as wood, metal, plastic or concrete as approved by the Town Clerk of the Town of Angelica.
 18. Concrete or metal vaults or concrete grave liners are required for full interment burials in accordance with provisions of the NYS Cemetery Board Directive 202.6. One full burial will be allowed per single gravesite, or interments of two cremation burials in a single gravesite. The interment of two additional cremation remains may be allowed on a gravesite where a full burial has previously taken place.
 19. No above ground vault or mausoleum may be built on cemetery lands.
 20. The Town Board of the Town of Angelica reserves the right to restrict entry to the Cemetery at certain times of the year or day.
 21. Access and driveways will be plowed in winter only on an as needed basis.
 22. The Town Board of the Town of Angelica may amend the rules and regulations presented herein at any time by a majority vote of the Town Board on a resolution to amend these rules.

Each grave site costs \$450.00; a full burial opening will cost \$350.00*; a cremation opening shall cost \$200.00*

*The full cost of any overtime or holiday double time for Town employee(s) required, for interments, shall be billed as part of the funeral by the funeral director and remitted to the Town of Angelica.
